
State Tax Withholding Tables Updated to 2023

Tax withholding tables have been updated to the year 2023 for those states that have released new rates for 2023.



Employees' Earned and Used Personal Time Hours Can Now Be Included on the Pay Stub

To help Minnesota organizations to comply with the State's new Earned Sick and Safe Leave law, we added a new configuration option to the **Setup Check Layout for Bank Accounts** page. As highlighted in the illustration below, the new option is labeled **Include Earned and Used Time**:



When the **Include Earned and Used Time** option is set to **Yes**, the pay stub portion of the employee's printed check shows their personal time information broken out into two categories:

- Earned: shows the total number of hours accrued (earned but not yet taken) for personal time off.
- **Used**: shows the total number of hours already taken for personal time off.

Note that if an employee has multiple personal time off amounts, the pay stub lists each amount on a separate line.



By default, the Include Earned and Used Time option is set to Yes for all Minnesota organizations.

By default, the option is set to No for all non-Minnesota organizations. If non-Minnesota organizations want to include personal time information on their employees' pay stubs, they can do so by setting the value to Yes and saving the change.



2023 IRS Tax Forms Now Available

Forms W-2/W-3, 1099, and 944 have been updated to enable reporting end-of-year payroll taxes for 2023. Customers who want to can submit Forms W-2 and 1099 electronically.

Personal Time Section Added to Paycheck Stub Report

When the newly added **Include Earned and Used Time** option (see previous note under <u>Setup</u>) is set to **Yes**, the **Paycheck Stub** report includes a **Personal Time** section showing the employee's personal time-off hours. The report breaks out personal time details into three categories:

- **Available**: shows the total number of hours available for personal time off.
- **Earned**: shows the total number of hours accrued (earned but not yet taken) for personal time off.
- **Used**: shows the total number of hours used (already taken) for personal time off.

Note that if the employee has multiple personal time off amounts, the **Personal Time** section lists each amount on a separate line.

Fixed: Cannot Add a New User Record

In **Church Manager**, when the user submits a request to add a new user record, the system appears to accomplish the task successfully. However, no record for the newly added user is found in the **Users** grid. This issue was resolved. The **Users** grid is now updated accordingly when a new user is added.
